



BATTING CAGE RULES



The following ground rules have been established by the Boys & Girls Clubs of Placentia – Yorba Linda to ensure the safe and efficient usage of the Club batting cage. These rules must be adhered to at all times during use of the batting cages. Individuals and/or teams observed to be in violation of said rules are subject to loss of privilege, as deemed appropriate by the Boys & Girls Clubs of Placentia – Yorba Linda.

1. The batting cages are intended for use only as designed, not as "play" areas. If the batting cage is not being actively used for its intended purpose, it must remain locked. Children are not permitted to play in the cage under any circumstances.
2. Abusive use and/or damaging of the batting cages will result in immediate removal and loss of privilege.
3. During use, only 1 player is permitted in the cage at a time to hit. Players awaiting their turn shall do so in the fenced coves with the fence door completely closed. Standing between the netting and the fence, or behind the protective pitching screen, is not permitted.
4. All batters are required to wear a Little League approved protective batting helmet at all times while in the batting cage.
5. When in use, the access gate must be closed, so as prevent outside observers from being exposed to hit balls.
6. No unsupervised "practice swinging" is permitted immediately outside the cage area. Soft-toss hitting, using wiffle-type balls, is allowed inside the cage, with adult supervision.
7. "Live" pitching in the cage is not allowed under any circumstances.
8. When the pitching machine is being used inside the batting cage, the pitcher/feeder must be an adult. Children are not permitted to feed the pitching machines under any circumstances.
9. There is a protective pitching screen provided in the batting cage. It must be used at all times to protect the pitching machine from hit balls.

I request that _____ be permitted to participate in the Boys & Girls Clubs of Placentia-Yorba Linda's batting cage. He/ She is in good physical condition, however should he/she become ill or injured during this field trip, he/she may receive necessary first aid. I authorize the Boys & Girls Clubs of Placentia-Yorba Linda to enlist the aid of a duly licensed physician, or admit my child to a hospital in case of emergency. I will not hold the Boys & Girls Clubs of Placentia-Yorba Linda, or its staff and Board of Directors liable for any medical aid rendered and will reimburse the Boys & Girls Clubs of Placentia-Yorba Linda for any medical or other expenses incurred for his/ her care. Additionally, I agree to waive all liability claims against the Boys & Girls Clubs of Placentia-Yorba Linda, its employees, and Board of Directors resulting from my child's participation in this activity.
